11:00 AM

11:00 AM: "Save America Rally" commences with headline speeches from members of the Trump family and close allies, including Eric Trump, Donald Trump Jr, and Rudy Guilliani.

12:00 PM

President Donald Trump starts his hour-long speech at the "Save America Rally." During his speech, he says "And after this, we're going to walk down there, and I'll be there with you, we're going to walk down ... to the Capitol and we are going to cheer on our brave senators and congressmen and women."

1:00 PM

Legislators meet at the Capitol for their joint session to certify the results of the electoral college.

1:10 PM

Protesters start to gather near the steps of the Capitol on both sides and start pushing back against the police.

1:26 PM

Adjacent buildings are evacuated by Capitol police after reports of a suspicious package.

1:33 PM

Rioters have entered the Capitol, mostly from the East side, and made it to Statuary Hall which separates the Senate and House of Representatives chambers.

2:11 PM

Rioters breached the West side perimeter and scaled the walls of the Capitol to gain entry.

2:22 PM

Vice President Pence was evacuated from the Senate Chambers.

2:24 PM

President Trump tweets "Mike Pence didn't have the courage to do what should have been done to protect our Country and our Constitution, giving States a chance to certify a corrected set of facts, not the fraudulent or inaccurate ones which they were asked to previously certify. USA demands the truth!", which has since been removed.

2:38 PM

President Trump tweets "Please support our Capitol Police and Law Enforcement. They are truly on the side of our Country. Stay peaceful!", which has since been removed.

2:44 PM

Shots were reported to be fired in the House Chambers.

3:13 PM

President Trump tweets, "I am asking for everyone at the U.S. Capitol to remain peaceful. No violence! Remember, WE are the Party of Law & Order – respect the Law and our great men and women in Blue. Thank you!", which has since been removed.

3:51 PM

The DC National Gaurd mobilizes over 1,000 troops to support local law enforcement.

4:07 PM

President-elect Joe Biden speaks from Delaware on the event.
